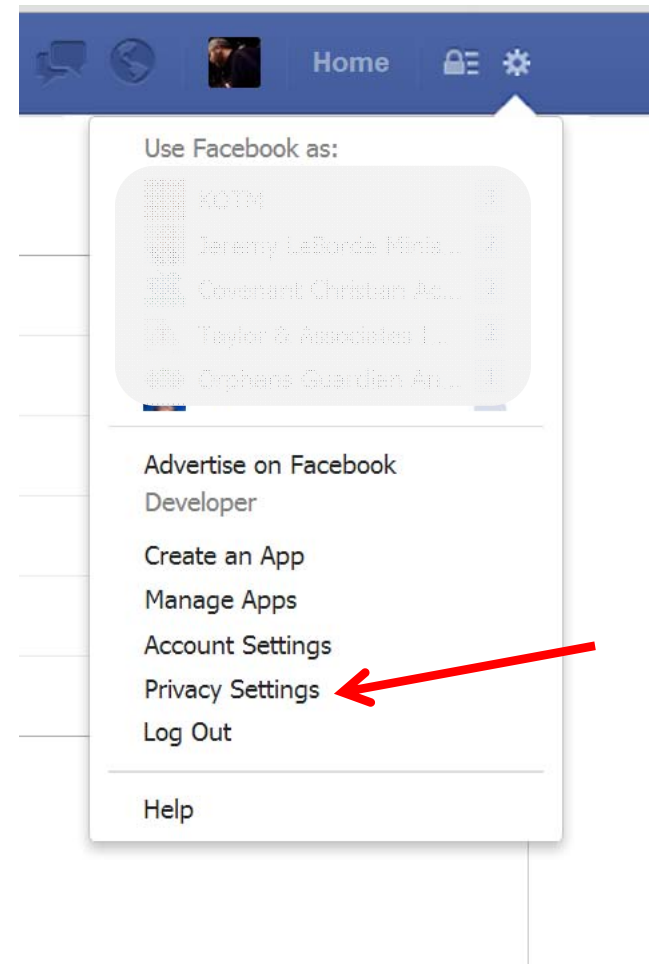

It is important for everyone to secure your accounts. Identity theft, harassment and even abduction can result from an unsecured account.

Here are some easy instructions on how to secure your Facebook Account.

Go to your 'Privacy Settings'...

This document will focus on Login Approvals, Recognized Devices and Active Sessions.


This is the screen we will work from.

Active Sessions

The **Active Sessions** section of your Security Settings page shows you a list of the recent times your Facebook account was accessed. Each entry includes the date, time and approximate location when signing in, as well as the type of device used to access your account. You'll also see the option to [end any active session](#).

This is important to review periodically and **ALWAYS** end any active sessions that you have not personally created!

When you select Active Sessions, select “End Activity” on any sessions that YOU did not initiate.

If you find sessions you do not recognize, you should change your password to ensure that no one can get back into your session.

Recognized Devices

Recognized devices are the computers and mobile phones you've saved to your account during the login process. You can view and edit the list of devices linked to your Facebook account.

It is very important for you to periodically review the recognized devices and remove any devices you have not personally used!

If you see any devices listed that you have never used, or you no longer use, REMOVE those devices from your list.

Login Approvals

Login Approvals is a Two Factor Authentication system that requires you to enter a code we send to your mobile phone via text message whenever you log into Facebook from a new or unrecognized computer. Once you have entered this security code, you'll have the option to save the device to your account so that you don't see this challenge on future logins.

Login Approvals is a good tool to use that will help protect the security of your account.

Click on the checkmark box “Require a security code...” and click “Save Changes”. Follow the prompts to verify your cell phone and begin requiring a security code for future login attempts.
